## ELA

We will begin the week by wrapping up Unit 1, Week 4. As we begin Unit 1, Week 5, we will be using rereading strategies to help us better comprehend various stories, while identifying the main idea and key details. We will also be learning about suffixes and how they can help us determine the meaning of new words. As we explore the characteristics of Persuasive text, we will be thinking of our essential question: How can starting a business help others? In Grammar, we will continue identifying the parts of a complex sentence and begin learning about how to correct writing run-on sentences.

### Math

This week in Math we will work with multiplying doubledigit by double-digit numbers using arrays, four square models, partial products and the standard algorithm of multiplication.
